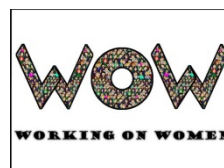

There are many other cases that are not reported to the police.</p>	<p>In France, one woman dies every 3 days at the hands of her husband = 121 women in 2013.</p> <p>25 men died from domestic violence (women were often in self-defense).</p> <p>13 children were victims of deadly violence by their father or mother.</p> <p>60% of police actions are a result of domestic violence</p> <p>In 2013, in the city of Quimper, there have been 73 reports of child abused or in danger</p>	Sinop Güç Birliği Derneği, an NGO, gives a financial support to women who are departed from their homes.
